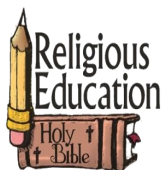
**MASS RESERVATIONS**

Everyone needs to register for every Mass, every week. Cut-off time for reservations is noon on Fridays. You may make your reservation for any of the 4 weekend Masses by:

- ⇒ using the Flocknote link that will be sent to you every Monday morning,
- ⇒ using the link on the website,
- ⇒ using the link on the St. Rose Facebook page,
- ⇒ calling the office.

**CURRENT MASS PROTOCOL**

- You need a reservation. Everyone must wear a mask.
- Enter through the front doors, exit the side doors.
- As you enter the church, your hands will be sprayed with disinfectant.
- Open seating, but to maintain distancing, sit in a numbered space.
- Be on time: doors are locked 5 minutes after Mass begins.
- There is no congregational singing. Sing as loud as you can in your heart.
- Remain in your seat for Communion on Sat/Sun.
- As you leave the pew, put the kneeler down.
- Exit the church right after Mass so volunteers can disinfect the church in a timely fashion.
- Praise God that we are able to attend this celebration!
