People are not property. We cannot exchange them at will or simply use them for our own designs and purposes. What does the word “commitment” mean to you? We can begin to understand its meaning by looking at some synonyms: dedication, devotion, allegiance, loyalty, faithfulness, fidelity, and bond. Commitment is primarily about relationship, and Jesus is all about relationships. How our lives affect others, how we treat our brothers and sisters, how we resolve conflict, and how we view the vows of marriage. Jesus’ teachings on obeying the commandments, murder, reconciliation, marriage, divorce, and adultery all stem from the sacredness of commitment. All of this has a God connection.

We can easily see one another as interchangeable and dispensable. We treat so much of our lives this way. What works today may not be what I want tomorrow. We search and search for the right thing only to find our hearts still restless in the end. Is real happiness achievable this side of the grave? Sometimes we expect too much out of others and want our relationships to fill a hole that we must figure out how to fill ourselves. Any seasoned married couple will tell you that their love for one another changes as time passes. Even though the understanding of romance changes as life changes, the dedication, devotion, allegiance, loyalty, faithfulness, and fidelity all remain and even deepen.

Some relationships can be hurtful, and God does not want us to live with abuse or pain. Also, how a relationship develops is sometimes out of our control, and we become the victim of someone else’s decision. But we can’t be self-focused in our relationships and see them exclusively as self-fulfilling ends. We are companions on life’s journey with varying depths of relationships being enjoyed by all who are with us along the way. We have the freedom to choose. God asks us to do so wisely, with right judgment and thinking.

**Fr. Ray's Book Review**

Chapter 3: This is That Sacrifice

In 1873 the book called the *Didache*, Teaching of the Lord through the Twelve Apostles, was discovered. Scholars still argue about when it was written. It could be one of the earliest Christian documents we have, written about 50 A.D. The *Didache* gives us a picture of the early Church when the Apostles were still alive. It is a complete instruction manual for setting up a new Christian congregation.

When the *Didache* speaks of the Eucharist, we can recognize much of it because it is similar to our modern Christian Liturgy. It is also something that any Jew would be able to recognize because they had adopted many familiar Jewish mealtime prayers. Paragraph 14 even quotes Malachi: "In every place and time offer me a pure sacrifice, because a great King am I, says the Lord, and my name is wonderful among the nations." The *Didache* presents a Church still in close proximity to Judaism and still developing its own distinctive traditions.

At the very beginning of Christianity the Eucharist was seen as a sacrifice, the one that Malachi said would be offered from the rising of the sun to its setting. Christians continued to offer sacrifices at the Temple since they were Jews. Sometimes Christians were thrown out of synagogues after heated arguments. They did not see themselves as something separate from the tradition of Israel. A few years later things will change for the Christians.

Rome eventually looked upon Christians as an illegal sect and Christians were arrested and put to death. In Israel the Jews will rebel and the Romans will destroy the Temple. As Christians began to die in greater numbers the Church continued to grow in numbers, thus fulfilling Malachi's prophesy of the pure sacrifice being offered everywhere at every time.

make claims about their ability to communicate with the dead, or having had a near-death experience. There is no objective way to verify any of this. While details about people and events can be surprisingly accurate, it is just circumstantial evidence that might be explained in other ways.

On the other hand, when people have unusual experiences, sometimes called near-death or out-of-body, it is real to them. They react with the emotions and thoughts that one would expect. At times, they report details they could not have known any other way, such as bits of conversation, or meeting people they had never known in this life. So certainly, to the person, they experience something. We believe in a life after death, we believe in the communion of saints. These things are not a contradiction to faith, but we should not base our faith on them, nor change our beliefs. They are unexplained and will likely remain so.

### Are near-death experiences real?

There is a lot of curiosity and fascination with the idea of an afterlife and communicating with those who have died. In movies, television shows, and numerous books, people

## SAINTS FRANCISCO & JACINTA MARTO

**Jacinta: 1910 - February 20, 1920**

**Francisco: 1908 - April 14, 1919**

Two of the three Fatima visionaries, this sister and brother along with their cousin, Lucia dos Santos, had monthly visions of Mary at Fatima, Portugal, from May to October 1917. Mary asked the shepherd children to promote devotion to her Immaculate Heart and pray the rosary daily. Both Martos died of influenza, Francisco at age 10 in 1919, and Jacinta at age 9 in 1920. Their cousin, who became a Carmelite nun, died in 2005 at age 97. Fatima is among the world's great Marian shrines and pilgrimage sites. On May 13, 2000, both Francisco and Jacinta were beatified. Pope Francis canonized the siblings and on May 13, 2017, on the 100th Anniversary of Fatima. Francisco and Jacinta are the first child saints who are not martyrs in the history of the church.

"One night his father heard him sobbing and asked him why he was crying; his son answered: "I was thinking of Jesus who is so sad because of the sins that are committed against him." He was motivated by one desire - so expressive of how children think - "to console Jesus and make him happy."

Our Lady needs you all to console Jesus, who is sad because of the bad things done to him; he needs your prayers and your sacrifices for sinners." - Saint John Paul II, on his apostolic journey to Fatima, May 2000.
