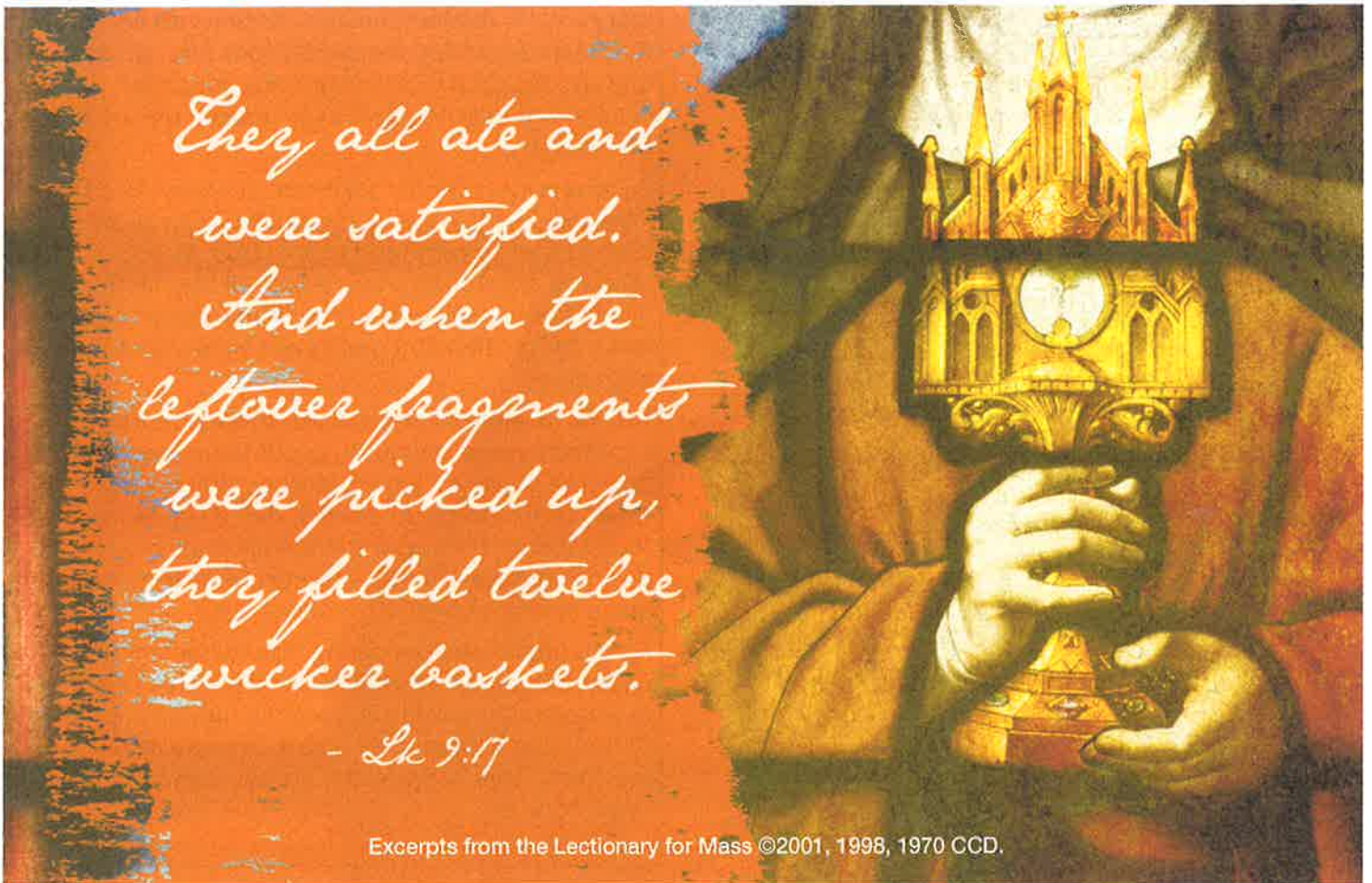

**Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ** "They all ate and were satisfied." Why read the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves this Sunday? Here we see the mystery of our physical and spiritual realities intermingling. Too often, they can feel separate. When we go to Mass, how often we appear more ordinarily human rather than stretching toward the divine.

Perhaps our experience of the Eucharist is fairly mundane. We notice when a new sacramental wine has been selected. We feel the varying textures of the host and wonder if they'll ever bring back the one that tasted distinctly like wheat. As we shuffle up to the front and stride back to our pew, we notice the looks on people's faces and the clothes on their backs. We get distracted by the crying child, the man blowing his nose, and the mechanical sound of the air conditioner kicking in. How human we are, how earth-bound, how material!

And how good God is for entering into these selfsame realities. How good God is for proclaiming "the kingdom of God," for "heal[ing] those who needed to be cured," for having mercy on a tired and hungry crowd. How many of the crowd noticed what had been done for them? Did they realize their dinner was a miracle? How often do we miss the deeper reality of the Eucharist? Even if in the moment of receiving Communion we don't experience radical ecstasy and don't feel any different, there is a tangible reality to cling to. Our God loves us enough to become bread for us, not only to feed us but to be fed upon by us.

**Fr. Ray's Book Review**

Now we look at the final pages of this book with chapter 13, entitled "Embers." This chapter raises the question, can Mary assist us to avoid lukewarmness? The answer is a resounding yes. Always she comes and sometimes without our calling out to her. Jesus' first miracle, by which Jesus manifested his glory and his disciples believed in him was not one that Mary asked for; she simply took it for granted. She was touched by the plight of a good married couple who may not have even noticed the intervention of Mary.

Lukewarmness cannot take root in a heart filled with love and devotion to the Virgin Mary. She disposes such a heart to know and to love God, directs its possessor to apostolate and integrity of life, summons him to confession, encourages him to begin again, and obtains abundant graces as he travels his path each day.

No one listened to God's words more attentively, kept them more zealously, or put them more faithfully into practice than his Mother. When we feel weak, unable to go on, tired or dejected, let us go to Mary. "Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and final grace in time of need." (Hebrews 4:16)

Mary's fidelity and joy spring from detachment, humility, prayer, being available and trustful. Her fidelity will encounter difficult, painful moments. But everything that happens will give it increase. Mary teaches us that happiness is always found in saying "Yes" to God.

## Why do we do that? Catholic Life Explained...

How do you explain "Real Presence" to children.

The first Communion class is filled with excitement to the point of bursting! They are just awestruck by every new thing they learn about Jesus. Their enthusiasm is contagious as they rattle off the names of the things in church, the vessels and vestments used at Mass, and the names of their pastors and priests. Of course, they know Christ can do anything because he's God. He comes to us in holy Communion because he loves us so much that he wants to be with us. And he comes to us in the form of bread and wine. We really receive him in the Eucharist.

Sometimes it is easier to explain this to children than to adults. Their faith and trust in Jesus is not limited by the questions and doubts that often come with the question of how he does it. Rather, they focus on the question "why," and the answer is something they can easily grasp: love. Christ wants to be with us because he loves us. Nothing is purer in truth or in faith. Not even the theological explanation of transubstantiation, or philosophical reasoning or symbolic references, come close. Christ takes on the form of bread and wine to be simple and approachable, so that no one is afraid or turned away. His love for us is complete and total. We try to love him the same way in return. For a child, it is simple. For us adults, we keep trying. "Unless you turn and become like children, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven" (Mt 18:3).
