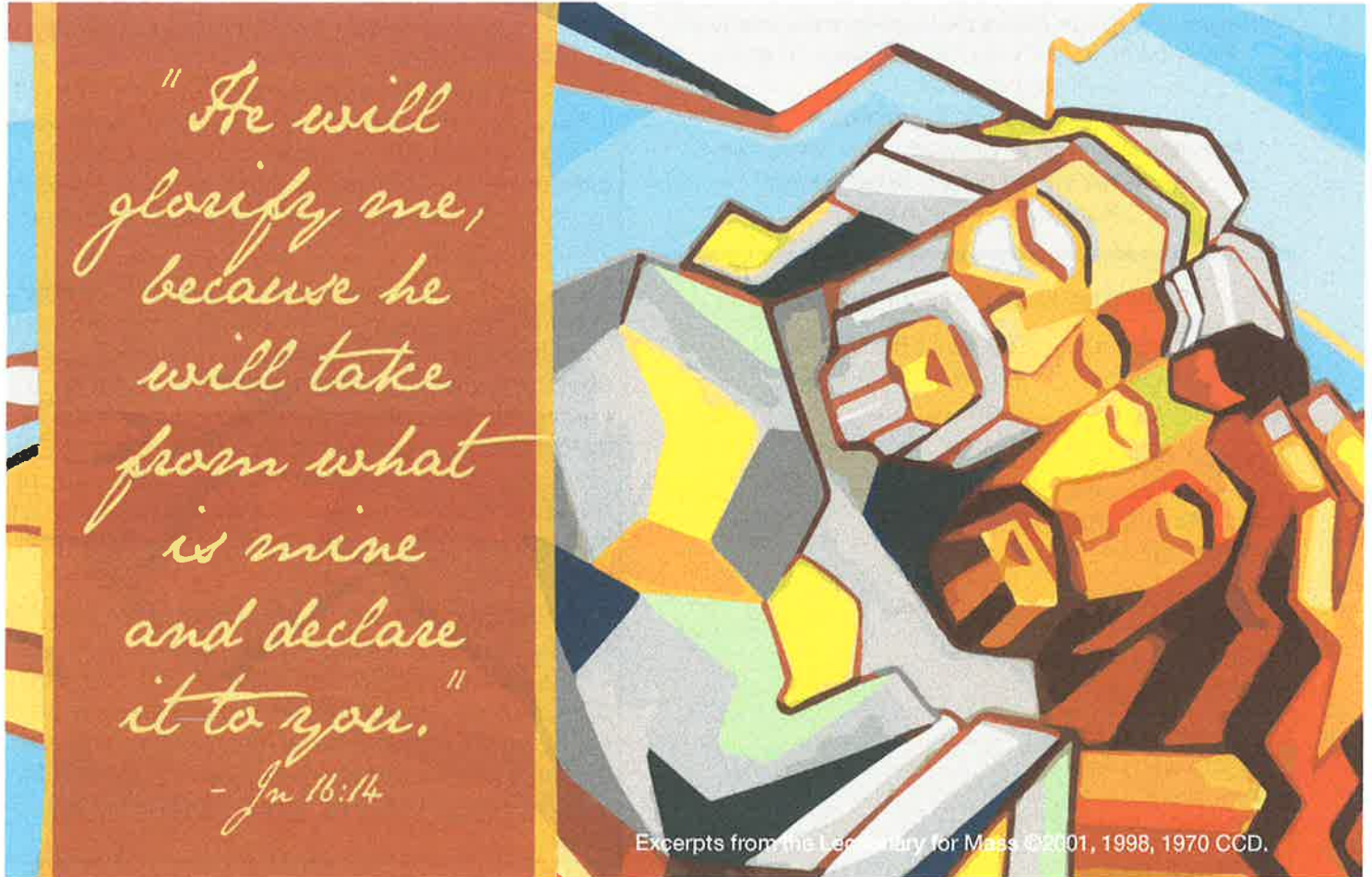

**Most Holy Trinity** If God is one, how can He be three? The most intelligent theologians have racked their brains over the problem, and the most prayerful ones have surrendered to the mystery. How it can be, we can't explain. But what it means, we can join! Our God is an ever-unfolding relationship. Theologians speak of the immanent and economic Trinity. The Trinity is immanent in the sense that the Persons are close and entirely sufficient within Godself. In other words, God doesn't require us for God to exist. The word economic is rooted in the Greek word for management of a household or family. The Trinity is economic in the sense that God has invited us to be part of Him. He's growing the family! We see the dynamic here in today's Gospel. Jesus says the Spirit "will take from what is mine and declare it to you" and that "everything that the Father has is mine." There is relationship here. Jesus speaks (and is) the word of the Father. The Holy Spirit speaks what He hears from the Son. The Father gives everything to the Son, and the Spirit speaks that inheritance over us. God invites us into the Trinitarian family! The doctrine of the Trinity isn't something to brush off as overwhelming. After all, "the Spirit of truth... will guide you to all truth." This occurs most perfectly in the Church, who protects all that has been revealed by God in Scripture and gradually unpacked in tradition. We can trust the declarations of Her theologians and learn from the lives of Her saints. The Trinity may be a mystery, but, by the grace of God, we can have real truth about who God is and how we can love like Him.

**Fr. Ray's Book Review**

Chapter 12 begins with a quote from St. John Paul II: It would be an allusion to try to seek holiness, according to the vocation that each one has received from God, without approaching frequently and fervently this sacrament of conversion and sanctification."

People who look deeply into themselves have no trouble seeing that they are not accomplishing all they are capable of. In many ways they are like old violins, worn out and perhaps missing a string. A lazy instrument and what's worse, out of tune. How different when we allow God to tune us and repair us. As God's instrument we will be surprised what we can accomplish.

Jesus is also our friend; we shall never find another like him. He is always willing to help; he listens to us, and encourages us constantly. Sometimes he acts directly on the soul, other times through the sacraments, channels of grace, and through persons or events that are vehicles for his gifts. But it is in the sacrament of Penance that the Lord restores us to the life of grace. Frequent confession prepares us to be good instruments, despite our many faults and sins.

A good confession should be: simple, pure, humble, faithful, frequent, clear, discreet, and deliberate, without exaggeration, complete, secret, contrite, brief, strong, self-accusatory and obedient. Each confession is a true spiritual resurrection. When a person is serious about complying with the will of God, weekly or biweekly confession is often appropriate.

## **Why do we do that? Catholic Life Explained...**

**I accept on faith that God is a Trinity of Persons, and I know it's something we can't fully understand. Should I just accept that, or should I try to learn more?**

There's a legend from the life of St. Augustine. As the early Church grappled with the identity of Christ and his relation to the other Persons in the Trinity, the holy theologian wrote a book about the Trinity. The story goes that, while he worked on the piece, he took a break to walk along the seashore. He came upon a small boy who had dug a hole in the sand. He was carrying a bucket, which he'd fill up with seawater and pour into the hole. Back and forth he walked. St. Augustine gently chided the young boy, "You can't pour the whole ocean into that hole." The boy responded, "And you cannot fit the whole Trinity into your mind."

The Trinity is a mystery! Our finite mind can't comprehend the infinite God. Of course, the lesson isn't about giving up trying to understand God. St. Augustine did write that treatise, after all. The hunger to know more about God is good. We can read books about the Trinity or about the fatherly love of God, the life of Christ, and the movement of the Holy Spirit in our lives. More than that, we can deepen our life of prayer. The heart of our Trinitarian teaching is "God is love." The Three Persons are an infinite relation of love between one another. Real understanding of that comes less through our heads but through our hearts.
